

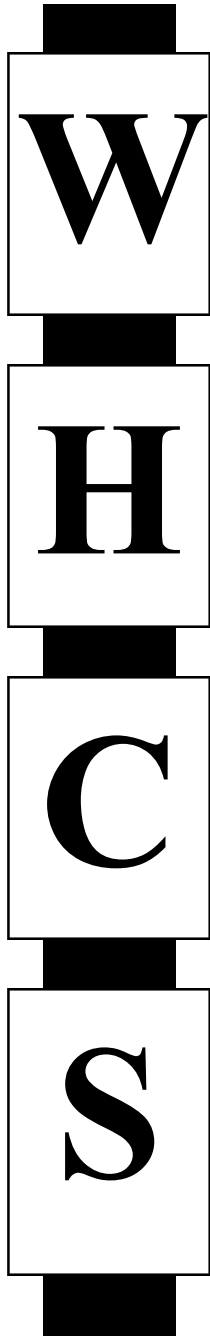

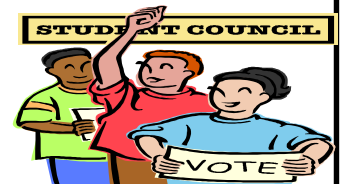


REMEMBER...THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOL OR EXTENDED CARE ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 6TH!

EARLY MORNING EXTENDED CARE

If your child is not signed up for either Early Morning Extended Care or Full Time Extended Care, please do not drop your child off before 8:00 A.M. Several students have gone to the cafeteria prior to 8:00 a.m. who are not in extended care. Beginning Tuesday, September 8th, any parent whose child is not enrolled in our Extended Care program and dropped off prior to 8:00 a.m. will be charged \$3.00 for each day. 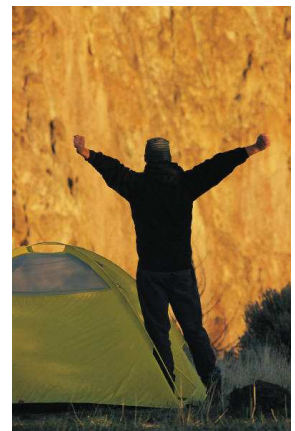


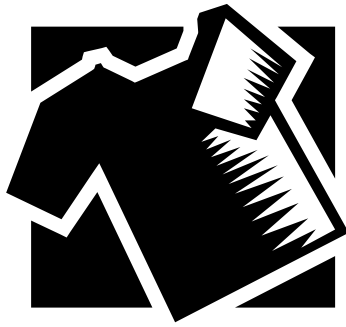
SEPTEMBER 17TH & 18TH 2010
